## Cyberbullying, Social Media, and Chat Forum Agreement

Individuals that have membership within the band program, whether staff or student, which are found using any social media platform, messaging app, or chat forum without the approval of the band director to disseminate band related information to their social media followers will face possible suspension, or removal from the band program and referral to the school's administration. The same penalty will be enacted for persons who post anything associated with the band program that could be considered negative.

Cyberbullying and bullying, in general, is unlawful and will not be tolerated in the Dillon High Band Program. Students that are found bullying another student, using negative or profane language towards the band staff, band parents, band volunteers, or other band students will be removed from the program immediately and reported to the School Resource Officer and School Administration.

In the event that a band staff member or school official discovers a chat forum or other social media platform being inappropriately used by band members, all members of the group will face dismissal from the band whether active participants or non-active. If a student is added to a group not recognized by the band director, it is in their best interest to remove themselves from the group immediately.
